



Ed C Browder securities all of the
county of Dallas and state aforesaid are held
and firmly bound unto the Chief Justice of Dallas
County and to his successors in office in the penal
sum of one thousand dollars for the payment
of which well and truly to be made we hereby
bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators
jointly & severally & firmly by these pres-
ents signed with our hands using scruples
for seals this the 27th day of August A.D. 1856.

Whereas the above bounden Andrew
Moore has been appointed by the Chief Justice
of Dallas County Master of William Briscoe
a minor about 13 years of age, and Lem
Briscoe a minor about 15 years of age. Now
if the said Andrew Moore shall support
maintain and give said William Briscoe and
Lem Briscoe two years schooling ^{each} and shall
also give to each of said ~~minors~~ ^{minors} a good suit
of clothes when they shall have arrived at
the age of 21 years, and perform all the
duties required of him by law under said
appointment then this obligation to be null &
void, otherwise to remain in full force and
Effect in law.

 sealed using screws for seals this 1st day of June
 1856

Whereas the above bounden Elijah
 Burges has been appointed by the Chief Justice
 of Dallas County Master of William Triscoe
 a minor about 18 years of age and Jenn Triscoe
 a minor about 15 years of age. Now if the said
 Elijah Burges shall support maintain and
 give said William Triscoe & Jenn Triscoe a
 good common English Education and when
 they shall arrive at the age of 21 years give to
 each of said Minors in Cash the sum of
 one hundred dollars and perform all the duties
 required of him by Law under said appointment
 then this obligation shall be null & void otherwise
 to be & remain in full force & effect
