To the Hon. the County Judge of Dallas  
 County Texas

Your petitioner Solomon Carr  
 a resident of Dallas County Texas respectfully  
 represents that he is the grandfather of William  
 Moses Carr and Morgan Josephine Carr  
 the first age six and the second eighty years  
 that they are the children and heirs at law  
 of his son Morgan Carr and Ellen Carr  
 his sons wife both of whom have been dead  
 about five years that they are entitled by in-  
 heritance from their late father and mother  
 to personal property consisting of horses  
 and cattle to the probable value of \$1000.  
 dollars to come so the administration he  
 has opened upon his late Morgans estate is  
 closed and that the same to the property or  
 increase of property given by petition to  
 his late son Morgan during his lifetime  
 that said minors were born in petitioners home  
 and he has taken care of their property free  
 of charge and sustenance and protection since  
 since the death of their parents bestowing  
 upon their property the same care and atten-  
 tion he did upon his own and upon them the  
 same care and attention he would upon his own.

 in June instant, (the same being the 29<sup>th</sup> day thereof,) then and their to  
 show cause, if any you have, why Letters of Guardianship of the  
 person & estates of William Mages & Margaret Josephine  
 Carver Minor Children of Morgan Carver  
 late of said county, deceased, should not be granted to Solomon  
 Carver who has this day filed with me his application  
 in terms of law, praying that the same may then and there be done. This 18<sup>th</sup> day of  
 June A. D. 1868.

The Condition of the above obligation is such, That whereas the above bound *Solomon Carver* has been appointed Guardian of *the person and estates of Margaret Josephine & William Moses Carver* Now, if the said *Solomon Carver* shall well and truly perform all the duties required of *him* under said appointment, then this obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect
