To the Sheriff or any Constable of Dallas County—Greeting :

Whereas, by an Order of the County Court of said County, entered on the 10th day of Aug, A. D. 1877, Hugh Murre guardian of the Estate of H. J. Carver is required to file an _____ of said Estate, and to pay the costs, that have accrued therein, before or during the next term of said Court, to be held at the Court House, in the City of Dallas, on the Third Monday in September A. D. 1877 .
