On this, the _____ day of September, 1899, came regularly on to be heard the application of R.E.L.Knight, for the appointment as receiver of the estate of Jennie Floyd, a minor; and it appearing to the court that J.S.Floyd, the father of said minor, waives his right and requests the appointment of the said R.E.L.Knight, and that the said Jennie Floyd being sixteen years of age requests the appointment of the said R.E.L.Knight as such receiver; and it further appearing to the court that a necessity exists for such receiver, and the court having been duly advised in the premises is of the opinion that the allegations of the petition are true,-- it is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court, that the said R.E.L.Knight, be and he is hereby appointed as receiver of the estate of Jennie Floyd, and as such receiver he is hereby authorized and empowered to loan the funds belonging to said estate or to use the same in the purchase of interest bearing and well secured note or notes. And he is hereby especially authorized to purchase with the funds of the said estate, a certain note executed by J.S.Floyd to F.M.Etheridge: said note bearing interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum; and stipulating ten per cent additional as attorney's fees, and retaining a vendor's lien upon certain land in Dallas county, Texas, and due and payable three years after date, interest payable annually.

To the Honorable Judge of said Court:

Your petitioner R.E.L. Knight respectfully represents that Jennie Floyd is a minor of the age of sixteen years, residing in Dallas county, Texas; and that ^{she} has an estate consisting of about four hundred and fifty dollars in money, in the registry of the district court of the 14th judicial district of the state of Texas, same being her interest in the proceeds of the sale of certain lands partitioned in said district court in cause No. 15352, entitled A.M. Baldrige et al v. J.L. Floyd et al; and that she has no legally constituted guardian of her estate, and said estate is likely to waste and to lie in the registry of said court without bearing interest; and that therefore a necessity exists for a receiver of said estate. Petitioner shows that he can with the fund belonging to said estate purchase from F.M. Etheridge, a note executed to him by J.S. Floyd, retaining an express vendor's lien upon a valuable tract of land, situated in Dallas county, Texas; and that said note bears eight per cent interest per annum, and stipulates ten per cent attorney's fees, and that such loan would be safe; and he prays that he be appointed receiver, and that he be permitted to buy the said note for the benefit of the said estate.

He files herewith the waiver of J.S. Floyd, the father of said minor, and his request that petitioner be appointed as receiver of said estate; and he also files herewith the request of the said minor for his appointment.

Wherefore premises considered petitioner prays that he be appointed receiver of said estate, and vested with the authority hereinbefore mentioned, and as etc.
