

Sec. 57. Every General Guardian appointed by the Surrogate shall, annually, after such appointment, so long as any part of the estate, or the income or proceeds thereof remains in his hands, or under his control, file in the office of the Surrogate appointing him, an inventory and account, under oath, of his guardianship, and of the amount of the estate, or the income or proceeds thereof, in his hands, and remaining in his hands, or invested by him, and the manner and nature of the same, in form of debtor and creditor.
