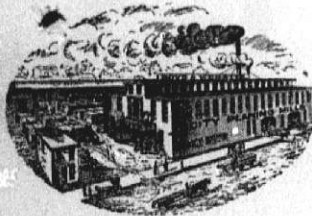

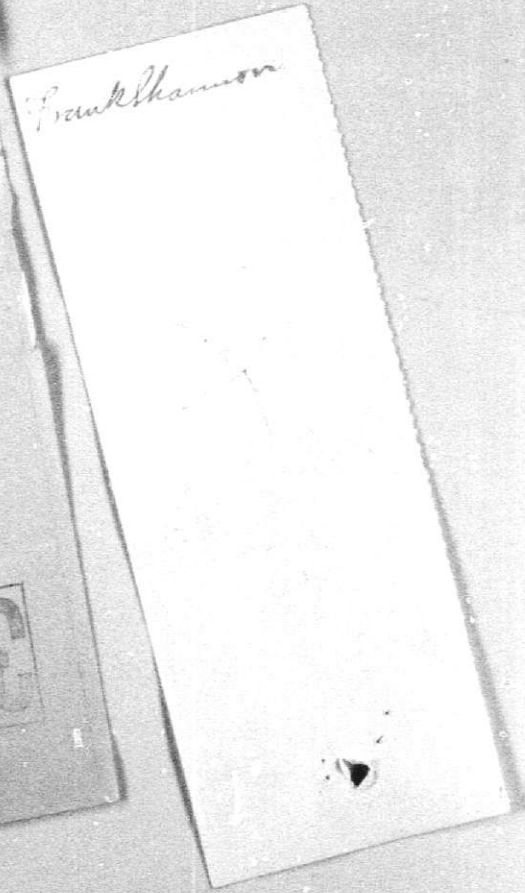
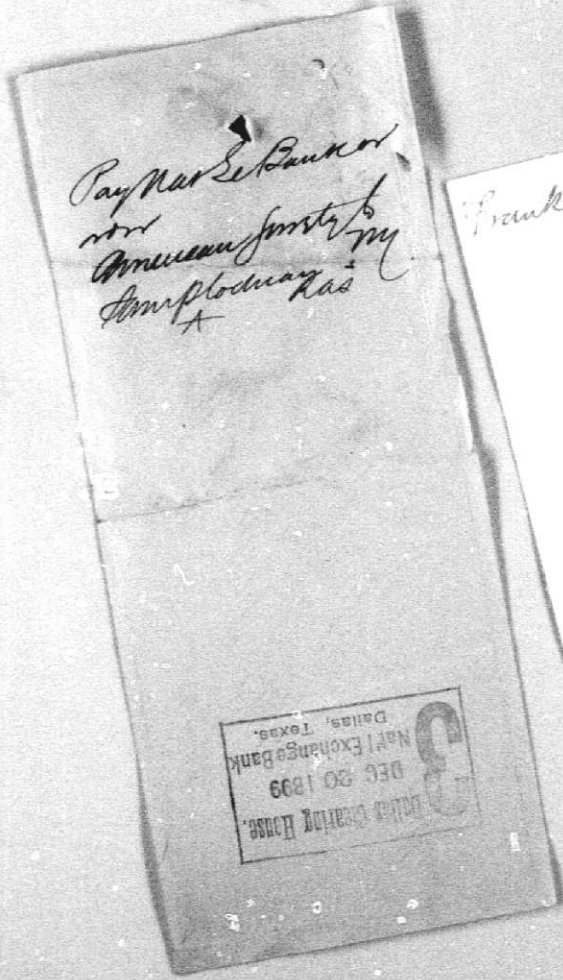

On this 19 day of November, 1903, coming on to be heard the final account of Lewis M. Dabney, guardian of Kate G. Wilson and Josephine Wilson, minors, and it appearing to the court that Josephine Wilson has sometime since become of age, and that the guardian under the orders of this court has fully settled with the said Josephine Wilson, minor, and that the said Kate G. Wilson is now of age, and that she has filed herein her waiver of notice of this application, and joins in praying that the same be granted, and the court having carefully examined said final account filed by guardian herein, and finding the same correct in all things except that the sum of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) disbursed by guardian for payment for premiums on his surety bond should be charged to said guardian; and it appearing to the court that the estate of the said minor, Kate G. Wilson, consists entirely of money in bank, to-wit, the sum of six hundred, seventy-four dollars and thirty-five cents (\$674.35); and it further appearing to the court that since the filing of the last account by said guardian, he has lawfully collected the sum of four hundred, thirty-seven dollars and two cents (\$437.02), and will be called upon to disburse the amount on hand, \$674.35, or the total sum of ~~ten~~ nine hundred, eleven dollars and thirty-seven cents (\$1,211.37), collected and to be disbursed, upon which ~~sum~~ sum, the guardian is entitled to 5% as his fees or the sum of sixty dollars and fifty-five cents (\$60.55), from which is to be deducted the sum of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) paid for premium on bond.

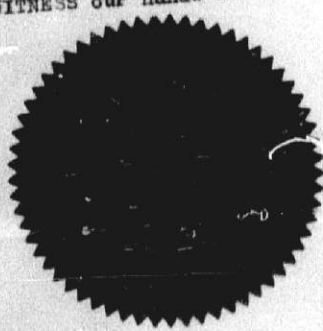
