petitioner respectfully represents unto your
Honor that Wm L. C. Bryan infant heir of Lemora
Bryan late of Dallas County Tex^s is without a guar-
dian that he is in possession of property to the amount
of \$1000⁰⁰ wherefore your petitioner prays the premises
considered that he be appointed Guardian for the estate
of said man, and as in duty bound will ever pray &c

case of one hundred & fifty dollars for the payment of
which will and only to be made in currency, his own
selon, on his executors and Administrators jointly,
and severally, firmly by these presents signed and sealed
with our seals, the seals being & crants this 29th day of
April A.D. 1887.

In consideration of this oblig-
ation we cede that whereas the above bounden James
W. Bryan has been appointed by the Chief Justice of
Dallas County, Guardian of the person & property of Mrs
L. C. Bryan infant heir of Leonora M. Bryan deceased

Now if the said James W. Bryan shall
will and only discharge all the duties required of him
by law under said appointment, then this obligation
shall be null and void otherwise to remain in full
force and virtue.
