Order Approving Bond & Inventory.

T T Holloway, Survivor. Thursday May 14th 1896.

On this day came on to be examined the inventory and appraisement and the bond of T T Holloway survivor of the above named estate; and same having been examined, together with the evidence thereon, and it appearing to the court that said inventory and appraisement is in proper form is verified by affidavits as required by law, and in all respects just, fair and correct; and said bond, being in proper form and conditioned as provided by law, and said bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars with E M Powell and W A Mason, as sureties thereon being considered by the court in all things sufficient. It is ordered adjudged and decreed by the court that said inventory and appraisement of said estate, and said Bond of Survivor be and the same ~~xxxxxx~~ are hereby in all things approved and ordered of record. It is further ordered and decreed by the court that said T T Holloway, survivor, be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to manage, control and dispose of such community property in accordance with law.

T T Holloway Survivor. Wednesday May 18th 1896.

On this day it appearing to the court from the application of Thos T Holloway a resident of Dallas County, Texas, that on the 9th day of January 1895, Edith Holloway the wife of said Thomas T Holloway, died intestate, in the City of Dallas, in Dallas County, Texas; that she left surviving her one child, Mildred Holloway, now five years of age; that there is a community estate belonging to the applicant and his deceased wife, consisting of certain real estate in Dallas County, Texas, besides personal property. That applicant and his said wife resided in Dallas County, Texas, at the time of her death; and that applicant, together with his said child has since resided, and now resides in said County; and said applicant desiring to qualify as community administrator of the estate of himself and his deceased wife, and has asked that appraisers be appointed. It is accordingly ordered and decreed by the court that C F Freeman, W. J. Morgan and Bryan Wells, be and they are hereby appointed appraisers to appraise the community estate of said Edith Holloway, deceased, and Thomas T Holloway, survivor, and due report make to this court.

whereas, the above bounden Thomas T. Holloway has been appointed administrator of the community estate of Edith Holloway, deceased, and Thomas T. Holloway, survivor, by the order of the County Court of Dallas County, Texas, now therefore, if the said Thomas T. Holloway shall faithfully administer such community estate and pay over one half the surplus thereof after the payment of debts with which the whole of such property is properly chargeable, to such person or persons as shall be entitled to receive the same, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
