Community Estate of

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, *F.A. White*  
as Principal, and

as Sureties, are held and firmly bound unto the County Judge of said County of Dallas, and his successors in office, in the sum of *Fourteen Hundred Dollars*: conditioned that the above bound *F.A. White*  
as survivor of the Community Estate of *himself and deceased Emma G. White*  
will faithfully administer such Community Estate, and pay over one-half the surplus thereof after the payment of the debts with which the whole of such property is properly chargeable, to such person or persons as shall be entitled to receive the same.
