Your Petitioner H. H. Brannon a resident  
of the County of Dallas and State of Texas respectfully  
fully represents that hereupon with on the 5<sup>th</sup> day  
of Novr 1871 Amelia Ann Douglass late of the  
same said County and State departed this life  
intestate leaving about 100 acres of land upon  
which she resided and personal property to the  
probable value of three hundred dollars that  
said decedent left Mary Louisa Brannon six  
years of age, James Davis Brannon now four  
years of age and Henrietta Brannon now three  
years of age her surviving children that upon the  
death of the said Amelia Ann she requested  
petitioner to take charge of her property and  
children pay her debts and to the care of said  
children and petitioner prays your Honor to  
grant letters of Guardianship of the persons
