 as Sureties, are held and firmly bound unto the County Judge of said County of Dallas, and  
 his successors in office, in the sum of Eight hundred and thirty two and 50/100 Dollars;  
 conditioned that the above bound David Jucifel, who has  
 been appointed administrator of the community estate of the late Carrie Jucifel dec'd.

will faithfully administer such community estate, and pay over one half of the  
 surplus thereof after the payment of the debts with which the whole of such property is  
 properly chargeable, to such person or persons as shall be entitled to receive the same.
