and reports that he has examined the final account of Sarah & Fry administrators of the estate of Mary Armstrong dec^d and the accompanying vouchers. and finds the same correct except as to the payment to L S Shau and the attorneys fee. The voucher for the payment to Shau does ^{not} appear to have ever been approved by the Court but from the personal knowledge of the Auditor the claim was due and has been paid.

There does not appear to have been an order of Court allowing the attorneys fee. This Auditor believes the services rendered by the attorney reasonably worth the sum of One Hundred Dollars the amount charged and paid. The Auditor recommends the approval of the attorney claim (J Skerfoot) and the approval of the final account. That said administrators be discharged in payment of ~~cash~~ in hand to the respective heirs of said dec^d.
