

Your petitioner Thomas Spruance a minor formerly of Green County Ill, and now of Dallas County Texas would represent that heretofore to wit at the Term of the Court of said Green County Ill, Samuel Spruance of said County was appointed Guardian of the estate of your petitioner. That your petitioner has since said appointment was made removed to Dallas County Tex, that he is now over fourteen years of age and otherwise competent to choose his own guardian. Be therefore pray that letter of guardianship be issued to Samuel Keller of Dallas County Tex in the place and stead of said Samuel Spruance and that a copy of said letter duly certified be forwarded to the Court of said Green County Ill and your petitioner thereby be enabled to draw his estate out of the hands of said Saml Spruance and place it in the hands of said Saml Keller.

And he would further aver that the services of the said Samuel Spruance are incompetent, that the said Spruance is engaged in a precarious business or trade and that the estate of your petitioner is liable to be squandered and totally lost to him.

Be therefore pray that his choice be confirmed at the April Term of the Hon. Court and such other and further reliefs be extended as justice may require
