*testament of John Record*

late of said county, deceased, should not be ~~granted~~ *admitted to Probate*  
*Sarah Record having* ~~who has~~ this day filed with me *her* application  
 in terms of law, praying that the same may then and there be done. This *9<sup>th</sup>* day of
