To the Honorable J. Ellis Coombes, Chf Justice  
 of Dallas County: Your petitioner Ann Pryor  
 who resides in the County of Dallas and  
 State of Texas, most respectfully, represents  
 unto your Honor: - That, heretofore, to wit on  
 the day of October, 1866, her husband,  
 Samuel C. Pryor, departed this life intestate,  
 in the town of Dallas, leaving seven children  
 who are now living; that at the time of  
 his death, he and your petitioner were seized  
 and possessed of property real, personal  
 and mixed, in said Dallas County  
 to the probable value of  
 dollars. Petitioner further says that the  
 accompanying paper, marked "A", contains  
 a full, fair and complete inventory and  
 appraisement of the community property of  
 petitioner and her said husband, at the  
 time of his death, and she prays that the  
 same be taken and recorded, as in cases  
 of administration, and that your Honorable  
 Court, grant her the right to manage, con-  
 trol and dispose of said community prop-  
 erty, both real & personal, in such manner  
 as to her may seem best, for the interest
