To the Honorable Thomas F. Nash,
Judge of the County Court of Dallas County Texas:

Now comes Frank C. Hernichell heretofore, to-wit: on the ~~✓~~ day
of February, A.D. 1895, appointed Temporary Administrator
of the estate of Mrs. _____ Decker, deceased, and shows to
your honor that upon his appointment as such Administrator
he took possession of the following personal effects of the
said Mrs. Decker, to-wit:

One Apron, Two suits Underclothes, Three gowns, Three chemise,
Two old dresses, One lot quilt pieces, Two quilts not finished,
Three pair pillow slops, (cotton) Three pair pillow slips,
(trimed) Ten sheets, Two quilt linings, Two strings beads,
One brass thimble, ~~1~~ 1/2 yds calico, 1 yd ribbon, 1 nut pick,
2 wrappers, 4 ladies waists, 1 1/2 yd gingham, 1 counterpane,
1 bonnet, 2 trunks, 3 bedsteads, 1 pr blankets, 1 rocking-chair,
1 mattress, 1 bed spring, 1/2 doz. iron spoons, 1/2 doz. china mugs,
2 cups, 1/2 doz. plats, 4 saucers, 1 bowl, 1 ladies chain, 3 gold
plated chains, 1 tub, 4 comforts, 3 under-skirts, 5 pieces cloth
4 quilts (no value), 2 feather pillows:

Of the above named goods, I have sold the following to the
various second-hand-dealers in the City of Dallas for the
best price obtainable therefor, to-wit:
2 aprons, 3 gowns, 3 chemise, 2 sheets and 6 1/2 yds trimming
for the sum of \$2.55.
3 bedsteads, 1 mattress, 1 bed spring, 1/2 doz. iron spoons,
1/2 doz. china mugs, 1/2 doz. plats, 2 cups, 4 saucers and 1 bowl
for the sum of \$1.50:
1 tub, 1 rocking-chair, 5 pieces cloth, 1 mat, 4 napkins, 1 apron
old rags and one chicken for the sum of \$2.42

Total cash realized \$6.47

All of the balance of the first goods hereinabove mentioned,
(not sold to the second-hand dealers) were by me distributed
among the children of the said Mrs. Decker:

Expenses incident to said administration were as follows:

Paid for drayage on said goods-----	.50¢
Paid for lodging for Will Decker-----	.75¢
	\$1.25

accept and relieve me of any further responsibility herein.
