 ly bound to pay to E. G. Bowen
 County Judge of Dallas County Texas
 and his successors in office the sum
 of Thirty Six Hundred and Fifty (\$3650)
 Dollars. The condition of the above
 is such that whereas the said W.R.
 Wilson has this day made his in-
 ventory of the community effects
 of himself and late wife J. S. Wilson
 and the same having been appraised
 according to law at the sum of
 \$3650⁰⁰. Now if the said W.R. Wilson
