Justice of Dallas County in the penal sum of
Three hundred Dollars for the payment of which
will and only to be made unto the said Chief Justice
we hereby bind ourselves, our heirs executors and Admini-
strators jointly and severally firmly by these presents
Signed with our hands & sealed with our seals, the seals
being servants, this 8th day of April - A.D. 1858.

The condition of this obligation is such that where-
as the above bounden Calon Cole _____ has
been appointed by the Chief Justice of Dallas County
Administrator of the estate of Thomas Stokes Recd.
Now if the said Calon G. Cole shall will and
only perform all the duties required of him by law
under said appointment, then this obligation shall be
null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and
effect.


