IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTATE OF JOHN P. O'HARE  
DECEASED ----- Probate Court of Dallas Co. Texas

To the Hon. Bennett Ferec, County Judge of Dallas Co. Texas :  
Comes now Mrs Mary Alice O'Hare widow of John P. O'Hare Deceased and represents to the court as follows :

1st:

That your petitioner Mrs Mary Alice O'Hare was legally married to John P. O'Hare Deceased prior to his death and was his legal and lawful wife at the time of his said death ; and as his surviving widow makes the foregoing statements and application :

That John P. O'Hare died on the 5th day of October 1899, at Dallas Texas ; at his residence on Cratcher Street in said City .

2nd:

That he left surviving him his widow your petitioner Mrs Mary Alice O'Hare ; and three children to wit: John O'Hare a boy 10 years old; Mike O'Hare a boy 5 years old ; and Winnie O'Hare a girl 7 years old. -- John O'Hare was born June 11th 1839 ; Winnie O'Hare born Nov. 30th 1892 , and Mike O'Hare born Jan. 5th 1895.

3d:

That there is a community estate between the deceased John P. O'Hare and your petitioner Mary Alice O'Hare .

4th:

That your petitioner and the deceased John P. O'Hare were long prior to his said death residents and citizens of Dallas County Texas , and resided in Dallas Dallas City Texas . That John P. O'Hare died in Dallas County Texas ; that he left community property consisting of lands and personal property all situated in Dallas County Texas ; to wit : among other property money to the amount of \$625.00 on deposit in the National Bank of Commerce , of Dallas Texas : a small amount of House-hold furniture, and Lots No. 148 and 150 Motley avenue Dallas City Texas ; being 50 feet front on Motley Avenue by 100 feet deep; That he also left the homestead being No. 252 Cratcher street Dallas Texas . That there are community debts due by the community estate . That said Community estate is of the probable value of \$2,000

5th:

Premesis considered you petitioner prays that the court appoint appraisers to appraise such estate , and that she be permitted upon filing inventory and bond , to qualify as surviving widow of the estate of said John P. O'Hare as is permitted by the Statutes of Texas.
