of Dallas County

Your petitioner Martin Brandenburg
of said County and State would respectfully
represent that the Estate of Henry
Brandenburg of said County died in un-
married, and his estate likely to waste and
decay and will suffer great loss except it
has immediate attention for that his Cle-
ary Landmarks Certificate in Peter Colony is
unpaid and the field notes not returned
to the agent of the Company nor can a
regular succession be obtained until it
can be made late to secure his land, and
your petitioner who is his father was un-
aware that it was necessary until after
the last term of your Honor's Court.

Wherefore your petitioner prayeth that you
will be granted to him for the purpose
of filing said Land Claim and sue the
and further relief as the Court may de-
em proper and right to secure his interests
and as in duty bound he will ever pray

County of Dallas that now Absalom Brandenburg
as principal and
as trustee and held & formerly bound unto the
Chief Justice of the County of Dallas on the sum
of Five Hundred Dollars for the payment of which
will and truly to be made now him or our executors
and heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and
severally firmly by these presents signed & sealed
using, Scratched for Seals This fifth day of July
1852

The conditions of this obligation are such
that whereas the above named, Absalom Brandenburg
has been appointed by the chief Justice of the
County of Dallas ^{pro tempore} Administrator of the Estate of
Henry Brandenburg deceased
now if the said Absalom Brandenburg shall make
and truly discharge and perform all the duties
required of him under his appointment then
this obligation shall be null and void, otherwise
to be and remain in full force and effect.
