To Hon. W. H. Ford Chief Justice
Your petitioner Martin P. Greene would respectfully
represent unto your Honor that Laurena Jane
Brittain, infant child of Brittain deceased
is without a Guardian for her person, and that
she is entirely without property, or debts of any
kind whatever, so far as he knows -

Your petitioner therefore prays that he may be
appointed Guardian of the person of said Laurena
Jane Brittain at the next term of your Honorable
Court, and that notice of such appointment
be as in duty bound will ever pray -

State of Texas - Know all men by these presents
 County of Dallas that we Martin Greene as principal
 and J. V. Morris & W. J. Jenkins as sureties are
 held and firmly bound unto the Chief Justice of Dallas
 County in the sum of three hundred dollars
 for the payment of which well and truly to be made
 we bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators
 jointly and severally jointly by these presents, signed
 and sealed with our seals the day being January this 25th
 day of February A.D. 1868 - The condition of the foregoing
 bond is such that whereas the above named M. P. Greene
 has been appointed by the Chief Justice of Dallas County
 Guardian of the person of Lareena Jane Brittain
 infant child of "Brittain etc." Now if the
 above named M. P. Greene shall well and truly perform
 all the duties required of him by law under said appoin-
 tment then this obligation to be null and void otherwise
 to remain in full force and virtue.
