When said will was made, the testatrix had no child living, and she did not make therein any provision for or mention of any child she might have thereafter. On November 17, 1902, a child was born to her of her marriage with this administrator, to-wit a daughter, Eleanor Rugg Hubbell, who is her only child. Said child yet lives, aged now about sixteen months. No guardian for the estate of said child has yet been appointed, but this administrator has now pending in this court an application for letters of guardianship of said estate. This administrator in his individual capacity waives in favor of his child any contingent right which he may have by virtue of said will to the portion of the estate of its mother which said child would have inherited if its mother had died intestate. Therefore two thirds of the net amount remaining of said estate will belong to said child and one third thereof will belong to James P. Hubbell, this administrator, in his individual capacity.

Now comes James P. Hubbell, who resides in Dallas County, Texas, and makes application for letters of administration upon the estate of his late wife, Carris A. Hubbell, and shows to the court as follows the grounds of his said application.

The said Carris A. Hubbell departed this life on December 15, 1902, at her home in the City of Dallas. Her domicile was in Dallas County, Texas, at the time of her death, and her principal property was then in said County.

Her estate consists of personal property; and its probable value is twelve hundred dollars. The chief item thereof is a past due note in the principal sum of one thousand dollars, which is secured by a mortgage on real property in Cook County, Illinois.

On December 26, 1893, the decedent duly made and executed her last will and testament, whereby she devised and bequeathed all of her estate to your applicant, and appointed him sole executor thereof without bond. Said will never was revoked, save in so far as the facts now to be stated operate a revocation thereof.
