Court of said County. Your petitioner James Guyton who resides in said County & State, respectfully represents: That heretofore to wit, on the 17th day of December A.D. 1886, he was a married man, and that the name of his wife was Lucy Hutson Guyton. That upon said last mentioned date, the said Lucy Hutson Guyton departed this life. That at said date petitioner & his said wife resided in Dallas County, Texas. That the said Lucy Hutson Guyton left

- surviving her the following children and no others, to wit: (1) John T Guyton aged 28 years, who resides in Louisiana, address unknown
 (2) Elizabeth S Lauter aged 26, who resides in Boyleston Madison County, Kentucky.
 (3) William A Guyton aged 23, who resides in Midland Texas.
 (4) Maggie H Guyton aged 21, who resides in Dallas Texas
 (5) Lucy H Guyton aged 19 who resides in Dallas Texas.
 (6) Annie M Guyton aged 17, who resides in Dallas Texas
 (7) Susan A M Guyton aged 15 who resides in Dallas Texas.
 (8) James Richard Guyton aged 13, who resides in Dallas Texas.
 (9) Kate C Guyton aged 11, who resides in Dallas Texas.
