Now comes your petitioner, Mary Elizabeth Corbin, joined by her husband, T. B. Corbin, in the above styled and numbered cause, and represents to the Court that she was lawfully married to James Elam on or about the day of , A. D. . That as an issue of said marriage there were born three children, namely: Beulah Elam, Luther Elam and Winnie Elam. That all of said children are minors. That Beulah Elam is about ten years old; that Luther Elam is about nine years old; and that Winnie Elam is about six years old. That James Elam, the father of said minor children, is dead, and that your petitioner is the mother of said minor children, and that she has provided for said children to the best of her means and ability, and has taken good care of them and of their estates. That under the constitution and laws of this State she is entitled to and has homestead rights in the lands described in the order of this Honorable Court appointing the said S. A. Murdock receiver as aforesaid, and that said homestead rights have been decreed her by the courts of this State. That your petitioner is now residing upon said land with her said three children, and that she is looking after and protecting their interests in said lands and estates, and that the same are not being injured or wasted. That the interest of said minor heirs in the lands and estates over which said receiver has been authorized by this Honorable Court to take charge and control is incapable of being divided and segregated from the homestead rights guaranteed your petitioner under the constitution and laws of this State, and that said receiver cannot take charge and control of said lands and estates of said minors without interfering with, impairing and violating the homestead rights of your petitioner.

Wherefore, your petitioner prays that said S. A. Murdock, receiver, be cited to appear and show cause to this Honorable Court why said receiver should not be discharged and said receivership be declared null and void and of no effect, and that on final hearing said receivership be stopped and annulled and declared in law null and void; for all costs in

this behalf incurred, for general and special relief, legal and equitable;
and for this she will ever pray.
