FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY EIGHT & 50/100 (\$588.50); conditioned that the

the community estate of herself and deceased husband, Will C. Love,
will faithfully administer such community estate, and pay over one-
half the surplus thereof, after the payment of the debts with which
the whole of such property is properly chargeable, to such person or
persons as shall be entitled to receive the same.
