To the Hon. Kenneth Foss, Judge of the County
Court of said County: -

Your petitioner, Bessie M.
Wiley, a resident of Travis County,
Texas, respectfully represents: -

That Emma White Boyd is
a minor and a female person, two
years of age on Feb 9th 1898 and
is now a resident of Travis Co. Texas.

That your petitioner has had
the care of, control and custody of said
minor, partially maintaining her
and providing for her out of petitioner's
own means ever since said minor
was about six weeks old.

That said minor's mother, Emma
Gaines Boyd, departed this life in
Dallas Co. Texas sometime during
the month of March 1896; that her
father Wm Boyd is now a resident
citizen of Dallas County Texas and had
never married since the death of
his said wife, Emma Gaines, and is
willing and desirous of having your
petitioner appointed guardian of his
said child Emma White.

That your petitioner is related

to said minor Emma White Boyd from the mother's side, being a second Cousin to said minor, and is not legally disqualified from performing the duties of guardian of said minor and is sufficiently able to support, maintain and educate said minor, although Mr Boyd, the father of said minor is desirous of contributing towards the support and maintenance of said minor.

That said minor has no property in this state.

Wherefore premises considered your petitioner prays, that citation issue according to law and that your honor will grant your petitioner letters of guardianship of the person of said minor and in duty bound will ever pray.
