Now comes Lizzie C. Brown, Guardian of the estate of the above named minor, and files this her Account for final settlement of the said guardianship, the same being her final report herein, and shows to the Court as follows:

1. The Guardian received as the sole property of the minor's estate, the sum of \$1000.00 in money, the same being a legacy left to the minor by a deceased relative. The Guardian loaned this sum for one year at eight per cent. interest. This sum was repaid to the Guardian before the expiration of the year by the borrower but the full year's interest on the loan was paid, so that the Guardian realized as interest the sum of \$80.00. The Guardian was unable to make any further loan or investment of said money. No other property or money of any character came into the possession of the Guardian other than as above stated.

2. In the matter of this guardianship the Guardian incurred attorney's fees to McCormick & Spence for services in preparing the appointment and qualification of the Guardian, and in the handling of the moneys of the estate, to the amount of \$15.00, and the Guardian heretofore paid the costs of court incurred herein in the sum of \$15.95; the expenditures, therefore, aggregating \$30.95. No other expenses were incurred by the Guardian, and there are no expenses or debts against the estate remaining unpaid.
