COUNTY OF DALLAS:

To the Hon., County Court of said County:

Your petitioner H.N.Haskell respectfully represents that he is a resident of the County of Dallas, State of Texas, .

That heretofore, to wit: on or about the 25th, day of Nov., 1890, J.R.Hayter departed this life intestate, in said County and State, leaving a community estate between himself and wife M.U. Hayter of the probable value of One Thousand (\$1000.) Dollars, situated in the County of Dallas and State of Texas; the subsequently thereto on the 3d, day of Nov., 1892, M.U.Hayter departed this life intestate in the County of Tarrant and State of Texas, leaving the community estate of herself and husband, situated in the County of Dallas and State of Texas, and of the probable value as above stated; that said estate constituted a portion of their property in the State of Texas; and that at the time of the death of the said J.R.Hayter and M.U.Hayter there was an indebtedness existing against them unsatisfied, which remains still wholly unpaid; that the same constituted a lien upon the said property; that your petitioner is not disqualified from acting as administrator of said estate of said J.R.Hayter and M.U.Hayter.
