ART. 2090. P. S., 1895.—If the guardian (administrator or executor) fail to return such account after being cited to do so, or fail to show good cause for failing to return such account at the proper time, he may be fined by the Court not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars, for the use of the County, and he and his sureties shall be liable for all fines imposed and damages sustained by reason of such failure.
