Sampson Eagon, who resides at the county of Dallas and
 state of Texas, respectfully shows to the court that he is the sur-
 viving husband of Mrs. Bessie Eagon, deceased: That the said Bessie
 Eagon departed this life in Dallas county, state of Texas on the
 9th day of March A.D. 1883, intestate: that she left an estate con-
 sisting of an insurance policy upon the life of this applicant,
 dated in November 1874 for the sum of five thousand dollars: that
 said policy by its terms is made payable to Bessie Eagon, her exec-
 utors, administrators or assigns: that she left surviving her, four
 children, the issue of her marriage with this applicant, all of whom
 are minors: that said policy of insurance of right belongs to said
 four children: that this applicant has made application to the
 Aetna Insurance Company, who issued said policy, to have it so changed
 that said children may appear as the beneficiaries therein, and he
 is informed by the said Insurance Company that the change can only
 be made upon a grant of letters of administration upon the estate
 of said Bessie Eagon, and that for the reasons above stated, a neces-
 sity exists for an administration upon the estate of the said Bes-
 sie Eagon aforesaid, and that the exact value of said policy in its
 present condition, cannot now be determined, wherefore, this appli-
 cant prays for letters of administration to him, upon the estate of
 the said Bessie Eagon.
