TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

YOUR APPLICANT, TEN-

NESSER A. SMITH, WOULD RESPECTFULLY REPRESENT THAT SHE IS A CITIZEN OF DALLAS COUNTY TEXAS; THAT ON THE 3TH DAY OF JUNE A. D. 1891 WILLIAM M. SMITH DEPARTED THIS LIFE IN DALLAS COUNTY TEXAS TESTATE; THAT HE DIED SEIZED AND POSSESSED OF A SMALL ESTATE CONSISTING OF REAL, PERSONAL AND MIXED PROPERTY, BUT PRINCIPALLY OF A SMALL PARCEL OF LAND, SITUATE IN THE TOWN OF CEDAR HILL, DALLAS COUNTY TEXAS; THAT UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE TERMS OF HIS LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, WHICH IS HERETO ATTACHED, MARKED EXHIBIT "A" AND MADE A PART HEREOF, YOUR APPLICANT BECAME THE SOLE DEVISEE OF ALL OF THE PROPERTY OF WHICH THE SAID SMITH, WHO WAS HER HUSBAND, DIED SEIZED AND POSSESSED; THAT UNDER THE TERMS OF SAID WILL NO ADMINISTRATION UPON THE ESTATE OF THE SAID SMITH IS TO BE HAD, AND NO BOND IS REQUIRED OF HER, SHE BEING APPOINTED EXECUTRIX UNDER SAID WILL, SAVE AND EXCEPT TO PROVE UP SAID WILL AND FILE AN APPRAISED INVENTORY OF SAID ESTATE. YOUR APPLICANT PRAYS THAT LAWFUL NOTICE BE GIVEN OF THE PROBATE OF SAID WILL UNDER THE STATUTES OF THIS STATE IN SUCH CASES MADE AND PROVIDED TO THE END THAT THE AFORESAID WILL MAY BE DULY PROBATED, AND AS IN DUTY BOUND SHE WILL EVER PRAY.
