 will and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs and legal  
 representatives jointly and severally, jointly by these presents  
 signed with our hands and seals with our seals using seals  
 for seals this the 1st day of \_\_\_\_\_ 187

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas  
 Jane Jones, wife of Jesse Jones, departed this life leaving  
 Community property belonging to herself and the said Jesse  
 amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Six Hundred and  
 sixty Dollars & <sup>75</sup>/<sub>100</sub>, which the said Jesse Jones as survivor  
~~thereof~~ desires to continue to manage & control & whereas  
 the said Jesse has filed an inventory and appraisement  
 of said Community property. Now if the said Jesse Jones shall  
 faithfully administer said Community property and pay over one half of the surplus  
 after the payment of the Community debts, <sup>to the surviving wife or her heirs</sup> then this obligation is to be null &  
 void, otherwise to remain in full force & effect.
