 County of Dallas B. W. Hanks deceased
 To the County Court of said County

Your petitioner Roseline E. Hanks
 would respectfully state to the court
 that she resides in the city and county
 of Dallas, in the state of Texas.

Your petitioner was during the
 lifetime of B. W. Hanks, his lawful
 wife, and is now his widow or relict.
 On the 27th day of July 1887 the said
 B. W. Hanks died intestate in the city
 & county of Dallas. The said B. W. Hanks was,
 at the time of his death, bona fide
 citizen, and actual Resident of the
 county and state aforesaid.

At the time of his death she and the
 said B. W. Hanks had the following
 children the issue of said marriage,
 to wit, Mattie E. Hanks, aged 17 years,
 William A. Hanks, aged 13 years,
 Sarah V. Hanks, aged 11 years, Mary
 R. Hanks, aged 10 years, Luella
 M. Hanks, aged 7 years, and Alice
 K. Hanks, aged 6 years. The foregoing
 are all of the children of the said B. W.
 Hanks left and they are all living now,
 and are residents of the city and

County of Dallas in the state
aforesaid. At the time of his death, the
said B. W. Hanks and your petitioner
owned community property worth
about one thousand dollars, all of
which was personal property.
The greater portion of said property
consists of a half interest in the
second hand store of Spivey and
Hanks Elm street in the
city of Dallas in the state aforesaid.
Spivey, the surviving partner of said
firm, refuses as your petitioner is
impressed believes to account for
a delinquent to her, all of the interest she
and her husband had in said store.
All of said property is in the County
of Dallas and the state Texas.

Wherefore your petitioner prays that affairs
be appointed, and that she be allowed
to qualify as the surviving wife
of the said B. W. Hanks, and control their
community property as the law directs.
