

Estate of Ed Bank, Dec'd.

County Court of Dallas County, State of Texas, (in Probate &c)

To Hou.E.G.Bower, Judge of the County Court, Dallas County, Texas.

Henry Struck, who resides in Dallas county, State of Texas, respectfully shows to the court:

That Ed Bank departed this life in Dallas county, Texas, on the 6th day of July, 1891, intestate; that he left an estate consisting of about \$160.00 in money, which was at the time of his death deposited in The City National Bank of Dallas, in the city of Dallas, to the credit of said Ed Bank; that said City Nat'l Bank will not pay said money to any one except some person legally authorized to receive and receipt for same; that said Ed Bank was not a married man and left no heirs at law surviving him in America known to petitioner. Petitioner shows to the court that he, amongst other citizens of Dallas, is a creditor of said Ed Bank for necessary expenses incurred in the last sickness of deceased Bank, and that petitioner is not disqualified from acting as Temporary Administrator of said estate. He shows that expenses for medical attention, nurses, doctors' bills and funeral expenses for deceased Bank are unpaid; that said expenses amount to about One hundred and forty five dollars, and that said expenses ought to be paid, and for the reasons stated an immediate necessity exists for temporary administration upon the estate of said Bank, and that petitioner is informed and believes said Bank had no other estate at the time of his death other than mentioned above. Petitioner prays that Temporary Letters of Administration upon said estate be granted to petitioner, and in case he is appointed as herein praved for that in the order so appointing him temporay administrator, that he be authorized to receive and receipt to said City National Bank for said sum of \$160. so belonging to said es-
