The petition of Jane Chism, a resident of said county, respectfully represents, that heretofore, to wit on the 20th, of August, 1904 in the said county, Solomon Chism, a resident citizen thereof, departed this life; and that decedent at the time of his death held a policy in the Knight of Pythias, col. Fratality of Texas of a personal nature of the reasonable ^{value} of \$ 300.00
