To Hon. Ed S. Lauderdale, Judge of said Court:

Now comes your petitioner, ~~_____~~ ^{P. R. [unclear]} by his attorney, and shows to the court:

That Mrs. Della McCarty formerly a resident of said County departed this life intestate on to-wit April 1st. 1901 in said County leaving surviving her a husband from whom she was and for more than a year next preceding her death had been permanently separated, during which time she had not heard from him and whose whereabouts and place of residence were at the time of her death to her unknown, and are to this petitioner unknown, and two children, viz, Rachael Bevels, a girl now 16 years of age, and Jack Bevels, a boy now about 12 years of age, both of whom are children of said decedent by a former husband.

That at the time of her death said decedent held a valid policy of insurance upon her life, which contract of insurance was for the sum of one hundred and twenty six dollars and payable to her executors or administrators, said policy bearing date Dec. 18th. 1899, numbered 686303, executed by The Sun Life Insurance Company of America, a corporation having its domicile at Louisville, Kentucky.

That said sum of money is now due and payable but said insurance Company declines and refuses to pay same, or any part thereof, to any person other than the duly qualified administrator of the estate of said decedent.

That there exists certain debts against said estate including expenses of last sickness and burial of said decedent, all of which are due and payable but none of which can be paid until the amount due on said policy of insurance shall have been collected, said estate having no other assets.

That the best interests of said estate require the immediate appointment of an administrator.

That your petitioner ~~_____~~, is a resident citizen of said County, and is a suitable person to be appointed temporary administrator, and is not disqualified in any manner.

REPORT OF THE COMMISSIONER OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE
IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROCEEDINGS IN THE ESTATE OF
JAMES M. HAYNES, DECEASED

Premises considered, petitioner prays that he be forthwith appointed temporary administrator of said estate, and that the order for his appointment may give full and necessary authority in the premises, including authority to the effect following, viz:

- (1) To collect with or without suit the amount due on said policy of insurance and receipt therefor.
 - (2) To pay such claims against said estate as may be approved by the court.
 - (3) To pay under orders of this court all reasonable expenses incurred by him in the collection of said policy of insurance, and in the preservation safe keeping and management of said estate, including attorneys fees and court costs.
- To pay over the residue of said estate under orders of court to the person or persons entitled thereto.

Your petitioner further prays that the amount of bond to be required of him as such temporary administrator be fixed in the order for his appointment.

To The Hon. Judge of Said Court:

Now comes J. R. Haynes, Temporary Administrator of the estate of Mrs. Della McCarty, deceased, and submits this his final report as such temporary administrator, viz:

That he collected from the Sun Life Insurance Co. of America the full face value of the policy on the life of decedent, which amounted to the sum of \$120.00.

That he has paid out of said sum so collected to Dunn & Co., undertakers, the sum of \$40.00 as burial expenses, as is shown by voucher #1 hereto attached.

That the court costs in said administration, including the order discharging temporary administrator, is \$8.00.

That the 5% of all sums collected and disbursed by the temporary administrator amounts to \$8.40.

That after the payment of the court costs and commission due temporary administrator there will be left on hand a balance of \$63.60, belonging to the heirs of said decedent.

That Howell and Rachael Bevell are the children and only heirs at law of said decedent, and that they are both minors, and that as such heirs they are entitled to said balance of \$63.60.

That J. R. Haynes has been appointed guardian of the estate of said minors by the County Court of Dallas County, Texas, and that he has duly qualified as such guardian.

Wherefore, premises considered, your petitioner as temporary administrator of said estate, prays that this final report be confirmed and approved by the court, that he be ordered to pay over to himself as guardian the said balance of \$63.60, and that he be finally discharged as such temporary administrator.
