To the Honorable County Court of said County:

Now comes S. A. That on or about the 1st day of August, 1899 said Lucy A. Sickman became the lawful wife of your applicant, and from the above mentioned date, your applicant has had the custody of said minor. And is in no way disqualified, and is the proper person to act as guardian of the person and estate of said minor.

Wherefore he prays ~~that citation be issued to Daniel Sickman, grandfather of said minor, and James A. Sickman, father of said minor, both of Hutchinson, Kansas.~~ and that notice of his application be ~~otherwise~~ given as required by law, and that he be appointed guardian of the person and estate of said minor.
