

To the Hon. E.G. Bower Judge of said court:

The petition of said guardian shows that by order of this honorable court, he is guardian of the persons and estates of the said Helen Jones and Mettamora Jones; that said Helen is now about sixteen years of age, and the said Mettamora is about fourteen years of age.

Petitioner shows that for about eight years past he has been guardian as aforesaid, and that during this time, as his accounts, presented from time to time and approved by this court, will show, he has prudently and lawfully used such means of his said wards as has been expended by him.

Petitioner shows that no personal property whatever belonged to the estates of his said wards at the time of his appointment as their guardian, except that shown in his first report as guardian, which was turned over to him by the administrator of their father's estate.

Petitioner shows that said personal property consisted of about \$321.92 in cash, one organ worth about \$25.00, one promissory note of J.C.R. Hayne for \$1000.00 and one promissory note of Petro Amato and wife for \$200.00.

Petitioner shows that all money from whatever source, including the sums named in said Haynes and Amato's notes and the proceeds from the sale of said organ, that has come to his hands as guardian, has been expended for the support and maintenance of said wards; that accounts, properly supported by vouchers, have been presented to this court embracing all said expenditures, and the said accounts have been by this court approved and allowed.

Petitioner shows that his said wards have made good progress

2.

in their studies at school; that they have shown that they are mentally capacitated for, and willing to receive a high order of education if an opportunity is afforded them; but in order that such opportunity may be afforded it will be necessary to supply them with a sum of money greater than their annual income yields.

Petitioner shows that the present income from their joint estates is \$42.50 a month, and arises from the rents of their joint property, and from this must be deducted insurance, taxes and repairs on property; but petitioner shows that these rents are being paid under contracts that were made before the present depreciation in the value of real estate and in the price of rents in the city of Dallas, Texas, where all said joint property is situated, and that when said rent contracts shall have expired, petitioner is satisfied that he will not be able to rent the property again for as much as its present rent price.

Petitioner shows that his said wards have no income other than the said rents; that their ages are now such, considering their station in society, that a larger sum of money is required for their becoming support and maintenance than is afforded from their incomes.

Plaintiff shows that he proposes to put his said wards at such an institution of learning as will fit them to be self sustaining, by reason of their education, either as teachers or otherwise; and this petitioner believes that he should do, as the estates of said wards are small and it may become necessary for them to be self-sustaining.

Petitioner shows that said organ was sold for the sum of about \$25.00, and the proceeds thereof, together with the proceeds of the sale of any and all property of whatever kind that has come to petitioner's hands, have been accounted for in his said accounts with the estates of his said wards.

Petitioner shows that his said wards have now neither money or

other personal property belonging to their estates, nor proceeds of sales of property, and their incomes are, as above stated, insufficient for their support, maintenance and education.

Petitioner shows that the real estate belonging to his said wards is all situated in the city and county of Dallas, Texas, and is more particularly described as follows, to wit:
