To the Honorable the Judge of said court:

H. C. Hoskins represents that he resides in the said county of Dallas, and has the custody of his two minor children, to wit: a daughter, Florence May Hoskins, about fifteen years of age, and a son Hubert Henry Hoskins, about twelve years of age, both of whom reside with him in the same said place, are without any legal guardian of their estate, and are jointly entitled to an estate of the estimated value of Two Thousand Dollars. And he files herewith a writing of the said Florence May Hoskins, signed by her and marked "A" whereby she waives the issuance of citation hereof, and chooses her father, the said H. C. Hoskins, to be the guardian of her said estate, and request the court to appoint him such.

Wherefore he prays that he be appointed guardian of the estate of said minors.

In the matter of Guardianship of Hobkins, Minors.

Comes the Guardian of the persons and estate of the Hobkins Minors, appointed by this Hon: Court - and represents:

That he is informed - and therefore believes that his wards are owners of an interest in certain lands situated on Galveston Island, in Galveston County Texas, <sup>and not from</sup> but that in order to establish and recover for his wards - a suit will have to be instituted in Galveston County: That the estates of said minors are of such character as will not allow them to engage the services of Atty to represent them in such suit - and pay Cash for such services - That said Guardian has been in correspondence with competent Atty in Galveston as to the best course upon which he will represent these matters - and has agreed with counsel that a contingent fee of one half of amount of land & property recovered is a fair and reasonable compensation -

Therefore he asks this Court to authorize and empower him as said Guardian to enter in and bind the estates of said minors in a contract - on the terms above stated - a copy of which is attached hereto -

These Articles of Agreement Witnesseth:

We, A. C. Hordine for himself, and Florence May Hordine and Robert Henry Hordine acting by and through our father and Guardian H. G. Hordine hereby contract and agree with M. C. McLemore Jr. of Galveston County, Texas - to convey by Special Warranty deed as the heirs of Galtie A. Hordine, deceased, an undivided one half interest in and do any and all real estate that he may recover for us, in the capacity above named in the County of Galveston, State of Texas, <sup>to him or his assigns</sup>

It being expressly understood and agreed that the said M. C. McLemore Jr. will institute and prosecute such proceedings in the proper Court or Courts to a final hearing and disposition of and it is further agreed that the said M. C. McLemore Jr. will pay all costs of such proceedings -

We also do hereby authorize the said M. C. McLemore Jr. to institute such suits for us and in our names and giving and granting him full power and authority to compromise or settle such suit as to him may seem best -
