 sum of Three Thousand Two Hundred and
 Ninety five (\$3295⁰⁰) dollars, Conditions
 that the above named H. B. Bennett who has been
 appointed survivor of the Community Estate
 of himself and his deceased wife Susan
 M. Bennett, will faithfully administer such
 Community Estate and pay over one half the
 surplus thereof after the payment of the debts
 with which the whole of such property is properly
 chargeable, to such person or persons as shall
 be entitled to receive the same. Witness our

Your petitioner H. B. Bennett would respectfully represent that he resides in Dallas County, state of Texas. That he is the surviving husband of Susan M. Bennett dec., whose decease took place in Dallas County Texas on the 26th day of April A.D. 1887. That the said Susan M. Bennett dec. left born to her and your petitioner, the following surviving children: Mrs. Mollie Pruitt, aged eighteen years, Annie Bennett aged sixteen, William Bennett aged fourteen, John H. Bennett aged twelve, Rufus E. Bennett aged ten, Jesse Bennett aged eight, Jennette Bennett aged seven and Lucie May Bennett aged five years. That all of said children reside in Dallas County Texas, That there is a community estate between his deceased wife and himself consisting of real and personal estate as follows, to wit: One hundred and sixty five acres of land, eight head of cattle, three head of horses, one wagon, and household furniture, all of the probable value of three thousand dollars.
