You are hereby notified, to be and appear before the County Court of Dallas County, in the State of Texas, at the next term thereof, to be held for probate and other like purposes, at Dallas in said county, at the Court House thereof, on the last Monday in April instant, (the same being the 27th day thereof,) then and there to show cause, if any you have, why Letters of Guardianship of the Person & Property of Gabriel Knight a minor under the age of 18 years John W. late of said county, deceased, should not be granted to J. H. Knight who has this day filed with me his application in terms of law, praying that the same may then and there be done. This 16th day of April A. D. 1868.
