A. D. 1893, A. C. Brown, husband of your petitioner, who, at and
before his death, had his domicil in the county of Dallas aforesaid
died in the said county of Dallas.

my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all wills by me heretofore
made.

Item First : I will and bequeath to my beloved wife, EMMA
Z. BROWN, all property, real, personal and mixed, owned and held by me at
the time of my death or to which I may be entitled.

Item Second : In the event that my beloved wife should not
survive me, then I will and bequeath all of said property to my beloved
children, Wm. M. T. Brown, Nellie Brown, Florence Brown, Maud Brown, Elwood
Brown and Emma Z. Brown, to be equally divided among them - share and
share alike.

Item Third : I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my


