1. That said Alberta and Edna Camuse are the daughters of your petitioner and her deceased husband E.F. Camuse; that they are residents of Dallas County, Texas, and that said Alberta is fifteen years of age and said Edna twelve years of age.

2. That each of said minors has an estate of the probable value of Six Hundred and sixty-six 63-100 dollars, (\$636.63), consisting of an interest of one-third each in a benefit certificate of ~~\$2000~~ Two Thousand dollars, (\$2000) upon the life of their deceased father aforesaid, the other one-third being the property of their married sister Mrs Thompson, wife of Thompson

3. That your petitioner, being the surviving parent of said minors, is the natural guardian of their persons and is entitled to be appointed guardian of their estates; and the said Alberta, being over fourteen years of age, has by a writing duly signed by her and filed with the clerk, waived the issuance of citation and made choice of your petitioner as her guardian.

4. The premises considered your petitioner prays that the proper citation for said Edna Camuse be issued and served, and that on the hearing an order be made appointing your petitioner guardian of the persons and estates of both of said minors, and for such other orders as may be necessary and proper in that behalf; and as in duty bound she will ever pray, &c, &c.

This day came on to be heard the report and exhibit of Mary W. Camuse guardian of the estates of Alberta & Edna Camuse minors filed herein Sept 4-1893. And the same being fully heard and understood the same is in all respects approved, and orders prayed for granted except request to invest money of said wards otherwise than by law required which is denied.

It is therefore ordered by the court that the inventory of the estates of said minors be corrected and amended so as to show \$615.¹⁶ as the estate of each of said minors as prayed, and that the liability of the said guardian be limited to said sum. It is further ordered that the purchase of the farms and acres therefor by said guardian be and is approved, and that said guardian be and is hereby permitted to expend the estate of said minors in their education and maintenance, and that the expenditures made heretofore by said guardian for the benefit of said wards and minors as shown by said exhibit and report be and are in all things by the court approved.

Mary W. Camuse, Guardian of the above named Minors, respectfully makes application, to have inventory filed by her be corrected so as to charge her with the sum of \$615.16 in favor of each of her said wards, and no more; and to be permitted to lend the money of her wards otherwise than as provided by statute; and also to be allowed to expend for the education and maintenance of each of her said wards a specific sum, to be determined by the Court, in excess of the income of their respective estates, and as grounds of her application she shows: -

1. That the estates of each of her said Wards, consisted of a one third interest in a benefit certificate on the life of their deceased father in the Knights of the Golden Cross, for the sum of two thousand dollars, (2000.00), and that under the provisions of the certificate said association paid the funeral expenses of the decedent in the sum of \$154.50 whereby the policy was reduced to the sum of \$1845.50, of which each of her wards received one-third to-wit the sum of \$615.16 and no more, and she prays that the inventory which was filed in advance of the receipt of the money, be so corrected as to charge her with said sum of \$615.16 in favor of each of her said wards.

2. That she has been unable to invest the money of her wards either in bonds of the U.S. or of the state of Texas or to loan the same upon personal security, with mortgage and power of sale on uncumbered real estate, as required by law, and she prays the Court to direct whether she may not with the consent of the sureties on her bond lend a portion of the money as she can do on interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum payable semi annually taking personal security therefor.

3. That in any event the income from the estate of her said wards is wholly inadequate for their maintenance and education and she as their mother is without any regular income and is unable to

provide therefor without trenching on the corpus of their estate;
She shows that her wards who have some literary and musical talents
and taste are desirous of qualifying themselves to earn a livelihood
as teachers and especially as musical teachers, and that she believes
that it will be to their interest to permit them to carry out their
said desire. Wherefore she prays the Court to make an order ratify-
ing the purchase of a piano heretofore made by her for their use at
\$350.00 and of a piano cover for same, at \$2.25; and to charge up to
each of them one-half the cost thereof. She shows that both of said
wards are in delicate health and their necessary doctor's bills
are very heavy, those of Alberta for the year of 1892 being over
\$70.00, and she prays that the Court will make such provisions as can
be lawfully done, allowing the guardian to use a portion of the
corpus of their estate in their education and maintainance in caring
for their health and in qualifying them for self support; And as in
duty bound she will ever pray.
