W. Crossman choosing the said Geo. W. Crossman as the Guardian of her estate, and it further appearing to the Court that Mrs. M.A. Sebastian, the mother of said minors, has waived her right to be appointed guardian of their estates and requested the appointment of said Geo. W. Crossman, and that said Crossman is in no way disqualified from acting as such guardian.

To the Honorable County Court:

Your petitioner G. W. Crossman respectfully shows to the court that W. W. Sebastian departed his life in Dallas County, Texas on July 7th, 1893, and left him surviving among other heirs his three minor children, viz: Miss Maggie Sebastian aged 19, and two boys Sydney J. Sebastian aged 17, and Walter E. Sebastian aged 12; that said minors have an estate in Dallas County, of the probable value of \$2000.00; that the interests of said minors require the appointment of a guardian over their estate; that the said two minors Miss Maggie Sebastian and Sydney J. Sebastian who are over fourteen years of age, have made the choice of your petitioner to act as guardian of their estates, as shown by the writing duly signed by them herewith filed, and made a part hereof.

That Mrs. *M. C.* Sebastian, the mother of said minor Walter E. Sebastian has requested your petitioner to act as guardian, also for the said minor Walter E. Sebastian. That your petitioner is twenty-one years of age, and is a resident of Dallas County, and is not in any manner dis-qualified from acting as guardian of the estates of said minors.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays, the premises considered, that he be appointed guardian of the estates of said minors, and as in duty bound he will ever pray, &c.
