Your petitioner Leonard Mathiss a minor,  
by his next friend A. J. Dye, represents that the said  
Leonard Mathiss is of the male sex, is fifteen years of age and  
resides in Dallas County Texas and is an orphan and a minor.  
That the estate of said Mathiss consists of about  $\frac{1}{2}$  interest

in 10 acres, in Dallas County about 3 miles N.E. from the Coal River, containing about 100  
acres, worth about \$500 an acre, and of about 1/2 interest in 1/2 acre in Kentucky, worth about \$25.  
per acre, or about \$12.50 per acre in Dallas County, with about 3-1/2 per acre, and of about  
\$150<sup>00</sup> in the Sister's Tennessee, bound out, & of \$100<sup>00</sup> due from A. T. Mathis in Dallas County,  
and the probable value of said estate as about one
