Your petitioner Simon Thomas respectfully shows to the Court that  
 heretofore on the day of November  
 1885 J. Hawkins departed this life  
 intestate in Dallas County Texas  
 possessed of the following personal  
 property situated in Dallas County  
 Texas to wit one black face Bay mare  
 with four white feet worth about  
 forty dollars. That there is a necessity  
 for immediate administration in  
 this that the mare above described  
 the property of said decedent is now  
 in litigation before this Honorable  
 Court in the case J. Hawkins vs  
 Charles Williams numbered on the  
 docket of said Court No 2728  
 and that said case is set for trial  
 on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1886 and there  
 is no one to represent the estate of  
 said Hawkins on the trial of said case

comply with the order of this Court

be appointed temporary administrator  
of said estate with power to  
appear and prosecute for said  
estate the suit hereinbefore  
mentioned, and to take charge of  
and collect the property belonging  
to said estate until such time as  
the Court may direct. And he will
