My dear Sir!

Your writing you to day from office of Siehr & Siehr at Insterburg, I found your letter of July 25th on my return here. I wish I had informed myself more fully before I left but you know how busy I am when home and how hurried my departure. As I understand your letter to require an order from the county court to convey any realty or part or interest therein, by the guardian. I explained the matter fully in my letter to you and Siehr & Siehr also address their instructions in German and I think you will understand it, they evidently believe that the approval of the County judge would be sufficient, if attached to our agreement or compromise, but if you think best or necessary to get an order from the court, please make the application at once, as suggested in your letter. As stated already the settlement is very advantageous, under the valuation by the court here the property was valued at 812,000 marks and would have been entitled to somewhere between 112,000 & 114,000 marks, out of which we would have had to pay our share of the cost, our part would have been 3500 marks, so that our actual share net 110,000 after considerable talk and endless negotiations we succeeded to get a compromise of 118,000 marks, it would take too long to explain how we managed to get it, but the fact itself is sufficient. The Estate consist of a large plantation with 275000 marks on which there is a close of 175,000 marks, a residence property here & furnished with 30,000 at a Villa in Salzburg Austria fit for a King but a very poor investment to rent for valued at 100,000 only brings 3200 marks rent for 3 1/2

besides this there are Scott's Industrial
 which are constantly declining amounting to 320,000
 besides this a few thousand cash and an interest
 in the firm of Knies & Werner, St. Petersburg,
 altogether about 800,000 Net. You can imagine
 how long it would take to wind up and divide such
 an Estate and I was glad that Urs Knies who
 inherits over 1/2 of the whole Estate was willing to
 pay us our part in Cash. We get 75,000 dollars
 a few days but the balance of 42,000 will
 be held till we can furnish the papers to enable
 the proper transfer of the Decedent's Estate
 to Urs Knies, so that title in her is
 perfect. Fischer & Fischer and others interested
 are very desirous to get this straightened
 out and it would be best to apply to the
 Commodity Court for the order at once. I have
 no doubt that it would be granted, and the
 Court way will be the best. The Proceedings necessary
 here are very much as you state them under our Law
 and when Germans live in foreign countries the Law
 of such country seems to govern, in other words
 my authority of guardian here is governed by the
 Laws of Texas and the Decree of the Courts
 which appointed me and not by the German Law.
 I do not know what to add as I have
 explained it fully and it will be easy
 for you to explain to the court that this compromise
 or settlement was strictly for the benefit and
 in the interest of my ward.

I am glad to hear that
 Governor Duller has again been vindicated
 and I do not fear the decision of our
 higher court, but feel sure it will affirm
 Judge Hays' decision.

Progress and modern up to now Ideas may
 be delayed by the Antis but always
 prevail in the End in a enlightened and
 progressive Country like our glorious
 Union. Even the magnificent all over
 world of the German Empire, the
 Imperial Berlin with its millions
 people is beginning to feel the necessity for
 expansion and the leading newspapers are
 agitating the annexation of about 10th
 Intubom Critics which have from 20,000 to
 40,000 people each.

I wish you could have been with me to help
 me to straighten out these endless difficulties
 and at the same time you might have enjoyed
 the change and good living in the German hotels,
 it is eating and drinking then from the minute
 you get up till you go to bed. However
 the climate would not suit you it is
 very disagreeable, cold and wet here and I feel
 sickly all the time. As the boys have again nominated
 me, I shall accept the job and do my best
 to assist in the work in becoming the popular
 President part of Governor Duller with regard
 to your family, partners and all the annexation
 your friends
