That the sum of \$50.00 a month would be a proper allowance to said widow for the maintenance of herself and minor children,said children being hers and the deceased's.

Wherefore your petitioner prays that the court set aside to said widow,Julia Robinson,the sum of \$600.00 for one year's maintenance for herself and minor children and that your petitioner be ordered to pay same out of said estate,making due allowance for such claims as may have precedence in the order of payment.

Your petitioner, therefore prays that this honorable court make an allowance of Two Thousand Dollars ~~xxx~~ in lieu of a homestead and \$500.00 in lieu of exempt personal property,if same can be done out of said estate,and if not that said petition er be ordered to set apart so much of said estate for said purposes as may be remaining in his hands after paying the debts which have a prior lien against said estate and the \$600.00 herein allowed for one year's maintenance.
