Dallas County } sitting for Probate business.
To the Hon. Elsbower, Judge:

Your petitioner, Wesley Boyd, respectfully, represents that he is a resident of said County, that heretofore, to-wit: on July 21st A.D. 1887 in said County Angelina Boyd, a resident citizen of said County, departed this life. That said decedent was the lawful wife of your petitioner and at the time of her death she and your petitioner were seized and possessed of Community property in said County and state of the probable value of \$1750⁰⁰. That said decedent left the following children surviving her, viz: John Boyd, aged about 19 years, Ed. Boyd, aged about 18 years, Houston Boyd, aged about 10 years and Allie Boyd, aged about 8 years. That the said property is real property and the condition of said estate requires the supervision of said court. That decedent died intestate and your petitioner is not disqualified for the administration thereof. Wherefore your petitioner prays that appraisers may be appointed to appraise said estate and that your petitioner be made administrator thereof and that such other orders may be made in the premises as to your honorable Court may seem fit.
