This guardian also states that the said minor has been an orphan for several years past.

and that from the 1st May 1872 the said minor has resided with this guardian and that during the whole of this time he has been boarded clothed and maintained by this guardian and this guardian states that the board of said minor from the 1st May 1872 to the 1st May 1874 was reasonably worth \$12⁵⁰ per month and he charges the estate of said ward with the value thereof which is 24 months at \$12⁵⁰ per month equal to the sum of & he credits himself therewith \$300⁰⁰

He states that from the 1st May 1872 to 1st May 1874 he expended in clothing for said minor this sum \$50⁰⁰ he states that he furnished said board & clothing to said minor out of his (this guardian's) own funds and he now charges

This guardian states that the said minor is the brother in law to this guardian the guardian having married the sister of said ward and that while the estate of the said ward has been exhausted, the said ward being an orphan and having no relatives with which he can live except the undersigned, the undersigned still desires out of his feeling for the welfare of said minor, that the said minor should remain with him as one of his family without charge therefor until

the said minor is in a condition and of experience sufficient to maintain and support him - self
